

## Megan Mustain, Ph.D., Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs

Megan Mustain joined Trinity University as Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs in June 2021. As Trinity's Chief Academic Officer, Mustain serves as first among equals on the President's cabinet and is responsible for advancing and sustaining

the academic mission of the university. She received a Bachelor's degree in Genetics from Texas A&M University before pursuing her Master's and Ph.D. In Philosophy at Southern Illinois University.

A Professor of Philosophy specializing in Classical American Philosophy, Mustain's research focuses on the work of philosopher and psychologist William James, the social philosophy of John Dewey, and the intersections of scientific, religious, and public thought. Before joining Trinity, Mustain served as Vice Provost for Academics and Dean of the Core at Saint Mary's College of California and, before that, as a philosophy professor and in a number of academic administrative roles at St. Mary's University in San Antonio.
