CAREER

Melody Woosley was appointed Director of the Department of Human Services in December 2013. Ms. Woosley is responsible for the City's Human Services programs and initiatives including Homelessness Coordination; Head Start, Child Care Subsidy Program, Youth Services, Family Security, Senior Services, Migrant Services, Non-Profit Agency Funding, and the Faith Based Initiative. She has oversight of a \$271 million budget and a personnel complement of 465 positions.

Prior to her appointment, Ms. Woosley served as Assistant Director of Human Services from 2008 to November 2012. In this role, she oversaw the City's investment in the Haven for Hope Campus, re-engineered the City's Head Start Program, expanded Family Security programs, and developed a consolidated non-profit funding process.

Ms. Woosley has over twenty-five years of experience with the City of San Antonio, where she has served in various positions before joining the City's Executive Team.
